**RESOLUTION #08/2018**  
**Core Funding**

**WHEREAS** the delivery of educational services requires planning and organizing to develop a sustainable system in the long-term; and

**WHEREAS** since it began operations in 2002 the Kwayaciiwin Educational Resource Centre has relied on short-term proposal-driven funding; and

**WHEREAS** funding for Kwayaciiwin Education Resource Centre is currently only available through Indigenous and Northern Affairs Canada's approval of unguaranteed, short-term proposal-based programming; and


**WHEREAS** the Kwayaciiwin Educational Resource Centre will be preparing service agreements with each of KERCC's participating communities.

**THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** that the Chiefs-in-Assembly mandate the Kwayaciiwin Board of Directors to negotiate for core funding for the Kwayaciiwin Education Resource Centre; and


**FINALLY, BE IT RESOLVED** that the Chiefs-in-Assembly mandate the Kwayaciiwin Board of Directors to explore options to access funding directly from Indigenous and Northern Affairs Canada rather than from each individual community and approve a process for direct funding access.
